FOR GREENER GROWTH

CORSIA is the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation. Launched in 2016, it was designed to help the aviation industry achieve **carbon-neutral growth through emissions reductions and offsets**.

A GLOBAL SCOPE

Since 2018, international airlines in ICAO member states have been encouraged to implement Monitoring, Reporting and Verification (MRV) systems for CO₂ emissions.

In 2021, compliance with CORSIA requirements will become mandatory for international airlines and cargo operators, impacting the 670 participating aircraft operators worldwide.

COMPLIANCE THROUGH VERIFICATION

CORSIA requires international airlines to **have their MRV systems and 2019 and 2020 CO₂ emissions data verified** by an accredited independent verification body like Bureau Veritas to establish an emissions baseline (see below). In subsequent years, along with **yearly reporting requirements**, they will be required to purchase **carbon offset credits** and achieve **emissions reductions** – through more sustainable aircraft, operations and fuels – to ensure they do not exceed baseline levels.

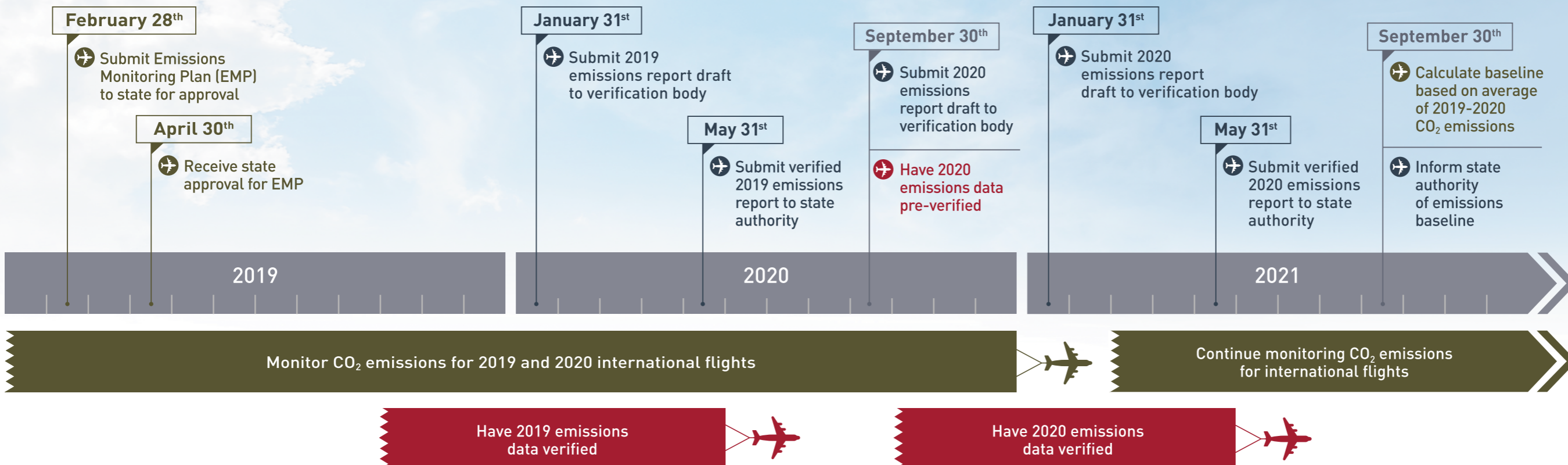

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES DURING THE CORSIA BASELINE PERIOD

International aircraft operators are required to **monitor, report and verify their 2019 and 2020 CO₂ emissions data to establish a baseline**.



In the future, in addition to yearly reporting, international aircraft operators will be required to keep their CO₂ emissions below baseline levels by improving fuel efficiency and offsetting.
